



EXAMPLE OF CLAUSE IN YOUR TENDERS

Unlocated or abandoned underground infrastructure discovered during excavation work

When an unlocated or abandoned infrastructure is discovered during excavation work, and if no information related to the infrastructure has been provided in bidding documents, the contractor stops the excavation work.

The contractor contacts the owner, if the owner can easily be identified, and together they decide what measures must be taken to carry on the excavation work in a safe manner. Failing that, the contractor contacts Info-Excavation by making an unidentified conduit (UC) type locate request, while providing pictures and as much information on the infrastructure as possible (colour, utility duct bank or conduit, writing on the cable, etc.).

Furthermore, the contractor informs the client and together they agree on the measures to be taken.
